



PEAFOWL

THE BASICS:

- PEACOCKS : male peafowl
- PEAHENS : female peafowl
- PEACHICKS : baby peafowl
- INCUBATION PERIOD : 21 days
- AVERAGE NEXT SIZE: 10 eggs
- The most commonly owned peafowl are the green and blue “India” peafowl.

THE EXTRAS:

- Like other birds, the male peacock is the most colorful and can have a tail that is five times longer than its body.
- The tail of the peacock grows out of its back, not its tail. The tail is used for courting during the mating season and they lose their tail feathers every summer.
- Peafowl eat mostly insects, grains and flowers but will also eat small snakes and frogs.
- Peahens make their nest on the ground and lay a brownish egg that is slightly larger than your average chicken egg.
- Peafowl are native to Asia and are the national bird of India.
- Peafowl are a part of the partridge, pheasant and quail family.
