THE BASICS:

- MULE: cross breed between a female horse and a male donkey
- HINNY: cross breed between a male horse and a female donkey (very rare)
- Mules and hinnies can NOT reproduce. They are born sterile.

THE EXTRAS:

- A Mule inherits the courage, speed and strength of a horse and the patience, sure-footedness and ability to survive on nothing but grass from the donkey.
- A mule has large feet, a strong back and long ears.
- They are used for work, especially planting of cotton, tobacco and sugar.
- The little ones are cotton mules, large ones are farm mules, larger ones are sugar mules and the largest are draft mules.
- Mules can pull carts and wagons like horses.
